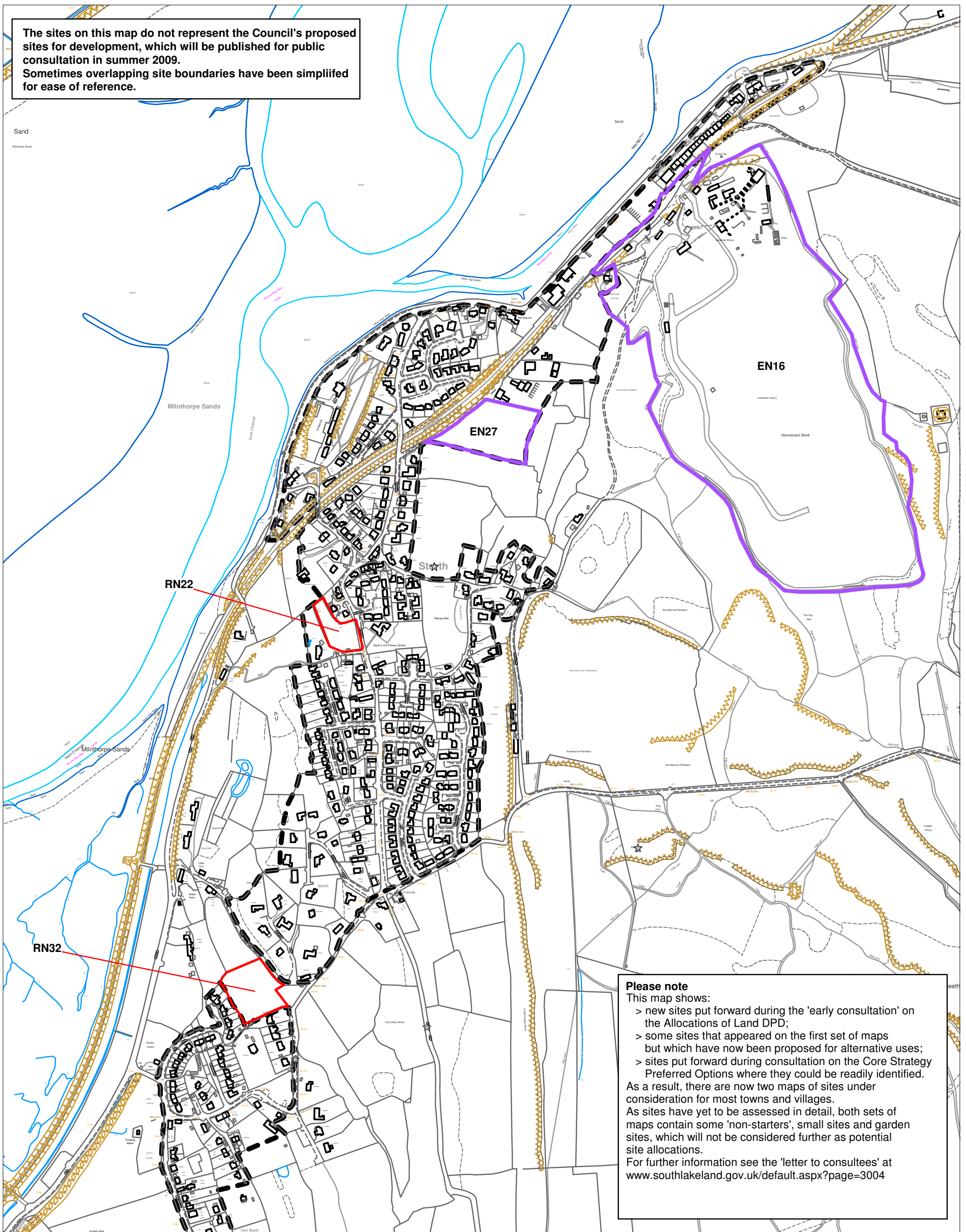


Allocations of Land Development Plan Document: Additional Sites for Consideration

The sites on this map do not represent the Council's proposed sites for development, which will be published for public consultation in summer 2009. Sometimes overlapping site boundaries have been simplified for ease of reference.



Please note
This map shows:
 > new sites put forward during the 'early consultation' on the Allocations of Land DPD;
 > some sites that appeared on the first set of maps but which have now been proposed for alternative uses;
 > sites put forward during consultation on the Core Strategy Preferred Options where they could be readily identified.
 As a result, there are now two maps of sites under consideration for most towns and villages.
 As sites have yet to be assessed in detail, both sets of maps contain some 'non-starters', small sites and garden sites, which will not be considered further as potential site allocations.
